

# Return of Results (ROR) User Guide

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## Preface

The Return of Results (ROR) is an area located on the Children's Oncology Group (COG) public website for those who are interested in learning the results of various COG-completed studies.

This site holds lay summaries of study results created by the ROR Committee. The ROR Committee designates which studies will be included on the site. Links to the study listing on ClinicalTrials.gov site are also made available on the site.

Included on the site are studies activated from 2012 onward and some that were in an active status before 2012. The posted summaries can be accessed on the website by anyone in the public.

In addition, you can register to be automatically notified once a new or revised summary of the study results is posted.

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## How to Use this Guide

This User Guide is divided into the following chapters. It is recommended that you first read through the Getting Started chapter to familiarize yourself with the basic workings of the ROR system before moving on.

**Chapter 1 – Getting Started:** provides information about accessing the system and its functional objectives.

**Chapter 2 – Email Notification:** describes how whenever the study's Summary of Results is posted or updated, an email is sent to your email address.

**Chapter 3 – FAQ:** Frequently Asked Questions regarding studies.

# Chapter 1: Getting Started

ROR offers the following features:

- You can download the Summary of Results files of completed studies or register your email address to be notified when the summary for a specific trial first becomes available or is updated. If you are interested in a summary for more than one study you must register for each individually.

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## Access

The ROR section is available to all users of the COG public website and can be accessed at <https://www.childrensoncologygroup.org/returnofresults> or by clicking the **Return of Results** link at the top of the web page.

**Results of Completed COG Studies**

NOTE: In order to view results, your pop-up blocker must be turned off.

To search for the results of a completed study, you can:

- Enter either the 8-character Study ID (e.g., AREN0533) or Study Title in the "Study ID or Title" field and click the Search button.  
OR
- Enter a keyword (e.g., disease type or drug name) in the "Study ID or Title" field and click the Search button. Any studies with that keyword in the Study Title will appear in the Search results.  
OR
- Select a Disease Type from the dropdown list provided and click the Search button. Any studies with that Disease Type will appear in the Search results; see FAQs for Disease Type definitions.  
OR
- Simply click the Search button and the list of all studies on the site will appear.

- Study ID
- Study Title – links to ClinicalTrials.gov.
- Disease Type
- Summary of Results
  - Register here link – links to register to be notified by e-mail when results are posted or updated.
  - View Results link – links to results summary. If no link, the results summary is not yet available.

When you click the link named **View Results** in the Summary of Results column, the study's Summary of Results PDF file opens in a new tab.


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## How To Be Notified When Results Are Posted or Revised

When you click the **Register Here** link in the Summary of Results column, a new tab with the header of **Enter Your Email Address To Be Notified When New Information for [study ID] Is Posted** is displayed for you to enter your email address.

Enter your email address in the text box provided. Only one email address is allowed.

Please note that you will receive notification when results are posted or revised. If your email changes, you will need to re-register for the studies in which you are interested.

## Chapter 2: Email Notification

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### Email Registration Confirmation

If you register your email address for a study in the Summary of Results page, you will receive a confirmation email. An email is sent to this email address when the study's Summary of Results is posted or updated.

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### The Summary of Results of Study Is Posted

When a study's Summary of Results is posted, you will receive an e-mail that contains the links to the ROR Search page and the Summary of Results.

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### The Summary of Results of Study Is Updated

This email contains the links to the ROR Search page and the Summary of Results. It also contains the reason for the update.
